Feast of Rosa Mystica—14th July.

The Feast of the Rosa Mystica will be celebrated in our Church on Sunday 14th July at 12pm Mass followed by lunch and refreshments and entertainment in the hall at 1pm.

History of Rosa Mystica—Mystical Rose

The history of the Mary Rosa Mystica goes back to the fifth Century when according to records of the Church, the figure of a rose was seen as a symbol of the Virgin Mary. In the Shrine of Rosenberg, Germany, the image of the Rosa Mystica has been venerated since 1738, but it was not until 1947 after appearances in Montichiari, Italy, that this devotion spread worldwide. The Virgin Mary made multiple appearances to Pierina Gilli, an Italian nurse. The first appearance was in 1947 when the Virgin Mary asked him for "Prayer, penance and reparation." The Mystic Rose appeared for the second time on 13th July the same year, dressed in white and on her chest she wore three roses: white, symbolized prayer, red symbolized sacrifice and gold represented penance. The Virgin appeared to Pierina five more times in the same year.

St Bonaventure

St Bonaventure (Giovanni Di Fidanza) known as the Seraphic Doctor was born near Tuscany in 1221. He received the name Bonaventure in consequence of an explanation of St Francis of Assisi when in response to the pleading of the child's mother, the saint prayed for John's recovery from a dangerous illness, and foreseeing the future greatness of the little John, cried out " O Buona ventura"-O good fortune. Through his preaching and good works, he converted even hardened sinners. He died on 15th July 1274. After his death, his head was found perfectly preserved and his tongue still red.
