### **St Bernard**

St Bernard was recognized as an outstanding preacher and orator, and many of his sermons have been preserved and excerpted in Holy Liturgy. Throughout his life, Bernard remained a devoted servant of our Blessed Mother. He often asked the people to seek her protection, blessings and grace. Bernard is to be given credit for the recognition of the sanctity of the Sacrament of Marriage in the Church.

### **Pope Pius X**

Over a hundred years ago, after a great earthquake hit Italy, in Messina, Pius opened the Apostolic palace for the refugees and homeless. Pope Pius X is best remembered for his encouragement of the frequent reception of Holy Communion, especially by children. During a papal audience, Pius went to hold a paralysed boy. While hugging the boy, he suddenly broke free from the hug and began to run around the room in joy that he had been healed. Another time, there was a couple he knew from his time as bishop with a child that had meningitis. They wrote a letter to him asking for his help. He wrote back telling them to hope, fast and pray. Two days later, the child was cured.

### **St Bartholomew, Apostle**

St Bartholomew was one of the apostles of Jesus. He has also been identified as Nathaniel in John's Gospel when he was introduced to Jesus by Phillip. He was witness to the Ascension. He preached in India, Greater Armenia, Mesopotamia, Persia and Egypt. According to legend he was skinned alive and beheaded.
