St Martha

Martha lived with her siblings Lazarus and Mary in Bethany near Jerusalem. She is depicted in the Gospels of Luke and John. She was a witness to Jesus resurrecting her brother Lazarus from the dead. She is the patron saint of homemakers and cooks.

St Ignatius of Loyola

He was a Spanish Basque Catholic priest, who co-founded the Society of Jesus. This order served the pope as missionaries. He is remembered as a spiritual director who recorded his meditations and prayers in a book called "Spiritual Exercises". He died in Rome on the 31st July, 1556, as a result of a severe case of Malaria. He is the patron saint of soldiers.

St Dominic

St Dominic was a Spanish priest who founded the Dominican order. He sold everything he had to buy food for the poor. St Dominic attributed to the spreading of the Holy Rosary which was according to legend given to him in a vision by the Virgin Mary in 1214. According to historians there was no record of the Rosary before this time.
