Saint Thomas

Thomas was one of the Twelve Apostles of Jesus, also called Didymus(Twin). He is commonly known as "Doubting Thomas" because he doubted Jesus' resurrection when first told of it; later, he confessed his faith, "My Lord and my God", on seeing Jesus' crucifixion wounds. St Thomas brought Christianity to India. He is often regarded as the Patron Saint of India.

Saint Elizabeth of Portugal

Saint Elizabeth of Portugal, known as Elizabeth the Peacemaker. She was a Spanish princess who was given in marriage to King Denis of Portugal at the age of twelve. She helped the sick and the poor and she founded many charities. She settled many disputes among royal relatives. When her son, Alfonso rebelled against his Father, Elizabeth rode between two armies to reconcile them. She died on her way to the battlefield to make peace between her son, then King Alfonso IV and Alfonso XI of Castille.

Saint Anthony Zaccharia

He was the founder of the religious order (Barnabites) and a promoter of the devotion to the Eucharist and the Passion of Christ. After his death, a number of cures were attributed to the intercession of Anthony Zaccaria, 27 years after his death, his body was found to be incorrupt.

His mortal remains are now enshrined at the Church of St Barnabas in Milan, Italy.

He was canonized by Pope Leo XIII on 27 May 1897.

He is a Patron saint of Physicians.
