St Cornelius

Cornelius was chosen as Pope in 251 AD over the objection of Novatian, who claimed the papacy for himself and was the first antipope. Cornelius and Novatian took opposite positions in the lapsi controversy. The lapsi were those who had "lapsed" from the faith during the persecution of the Roman emperor Decius (249-251 AD). The lapsi renounced their Christianity to save themselves from martyrdom. When the persecution subsided, the lapsi sought to be readmitted. Novatian, declared that those who had disowned Christ and the Church could not be forgiven, reconciled with the Church, or readmitted. Cornelius said that the Church had the power to reconcile and readmit the lapsi after a period of penance. Novatian and his followers were excommunicated by Cornelius. When Christian persecution resumed in 253, Cornelius was exiled to Centumcellae, where he died either from hardships or decapitation.

St Andrew Kim Tae-gon

The first Korean Catholic priest and a martyr. Born on August 21 1821, Andrew came from a family of martyrs. During the 19th century, Catholics in Korea were persecuted by the ruling Joseon Dynasty for abandoning Confucianism and Andrew's great-grandfather, Kim Chin-hu Pius, died in prison in 1814 after being arrested for his conversion to Catholicism. The saint's father, Kim Chae-jun Ignatius, was also martyred in 1839. Andrew was sentenced to death and was beheaded on September 16, 1846 on the banks of the Han River near Seoul, after prolonged torture.

St Matthew

Matthew, was one of the twelve Apostles of Christ. Matthew wrote the first Gospel of the Bible's New Testament, now known as the Gospel of Matthew. Prior to preaching the word of God, he worked as a tax collector in Capernaum. Many people felt that he was unworthy to be chosen as a follower of Jesus. The Jews considered the tax collectors traitors. Matthew is also, the only Evangelist who shares the eight Beatitudes with his readers. After Jesus' Ascension, Matthew preached the Gospel in Ethiopia and other sections of the continent of Africa.. Matthew was killed on the orders of the king of Ethiopia while celebrating Mass at the altar.
